

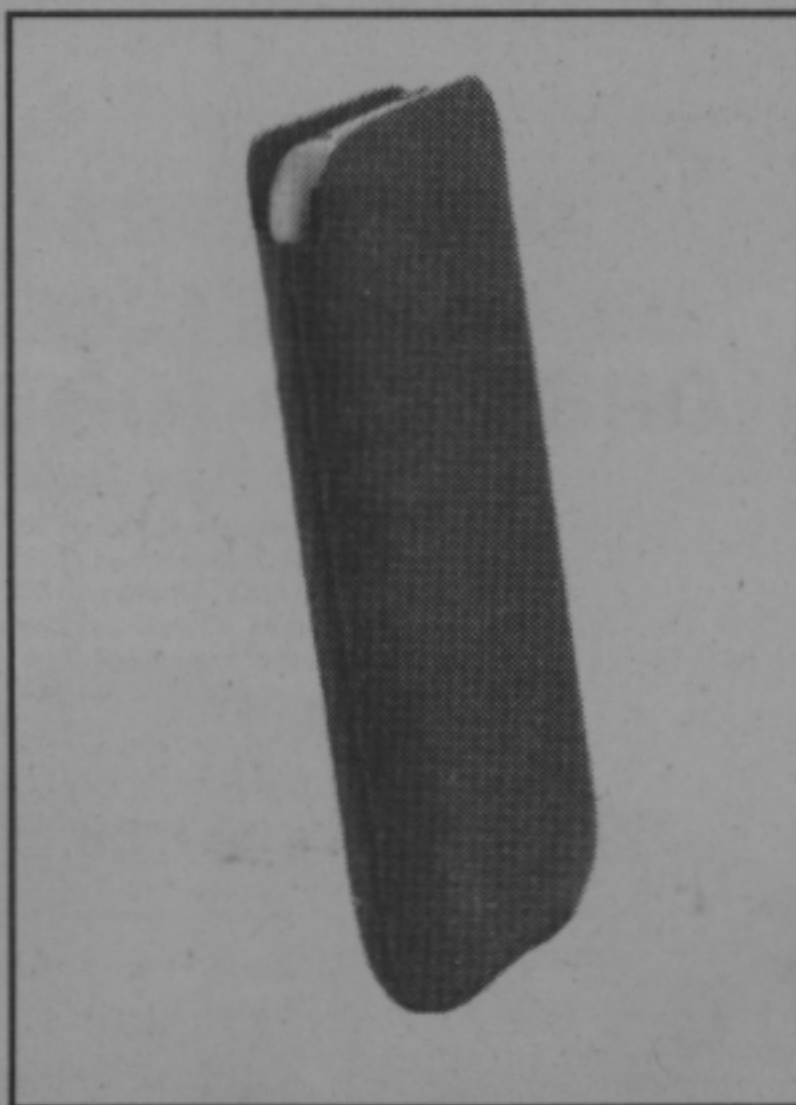

## iPhone accessories

It's no surprise that many new cases and accessories have been rushed out for the iPhone. While some of the first products were overpriced and not very well designed, there are now some better choices. My favorite cases are **Sena's** UltraSlim Pouch, a thin, elegant leather case that

adds minimal bulk (\$29, [www.senacases.com](http://www.senacases.com)); **DLO's** lambskin leather HipCase that attaches to your belt (\$35, [dlo.com](http://dlo.com)); and **Marware's** Sidewinder, another belt case that has a retractable side arm for storing your earphones (\$25, [marware.com](http://marware.com)). Another iPhone accessory, the InCharge Auto by **XtremeMac**, powers and charges your iPhone from a vehicle's 12-volt accessory outlet. It also includes a USB port for charging other devices (\$20, [xtrememac.com](http://xtrememac.com)).
