Craftsmanship

Sena has paid extreme attention to detail on this case which is made of genuine European Napa Leather with velvet lining. The craftsmanship of this case is superb and it doesn't feel cheaply made at all. This is definitely a case that will last you a long time.

Protection

I'm the type of person that wants my phone to be protected not only while its on my hip but also while I'm browsing the web or making phone calls, and this Sena case definitely does a good job of protecting my \$500 iPhone. Not only are the sides and back of the phone protected but this case also has the flap with magnetic closure that protects the screen, which in my opinion is the most important part of the phone. I also like the fact that the front flap is attached on the top of the case as opposed to the bottom, which is a bit cumbersome to get used to. The only places that the phone is exposed are on the corners of the case, and you'd have to drop the phone pretty precisely to hit those.
