---Doug: First thing I am going to review this week, as I promised to review it from last week is on the Sena Cases Magnet Flipper case, it is a very nice case for the iPhone. The difference between this case and the one we reviewed last week is that this one actually locks your iPhone into the case. And it has a flip that flips down to protect the face of the iPhone which is magnetically sunked into the front of the case. It just snaps on there. It has a very nice clip. When I first got the case I did not have the clip. Charles brought me the clip. It was still a very good case. The leather on the case is very nice, a stylish and very professional look. I have a black case. I had a Belkin iPhone case. It looked good, but everyone saw that I had an iPhone. Sometimes you do not want people to see that you have an iPhone because it draws too much attention.

---Charles: Yeah. I understand that.

--- Doug: But this kind of case flips down when you put it in your pants or on your belt. And people do not know what you have until you pull it out. It has little holes at the bottom for the microphone and the speaker, and it has an opening so you can charge it, which I really liked. If you open the flip and flip the flap. It flips down. I kind of thought that flap was going to flip up. At first I did not think that I would like it. But after I played with it little more I really liked the fact that it did flipped down because when you are using the phone if it flips up and it will really get in your way. So having it flipped down is a really good feature and makes answering the phone really easy.

You can just pop it out and it just flips right down. It is cut perfectly so that you have a space for your microphone and/or your ear piece and there is an opening so you can use your volume buttons on your case there.

--- Charles: Is there an opening for the camera, too?

--- Doug: Yes there is an opening on the back for the camera and that is how you get to your reset buttons. And one for when you put in your head phone jack. But one of the features I really, really liked is this clip. I had number of iPhone cases. I said that the Belkin case clips just were not good. This clip is solid and when it clips onto your belt you feel like it will stay there. And this is an expensive phone. They took the time to design a clip that is not going to just break off or anything, and it is going to really hold tight. It is offered in pretty much any color you want to match with your fashion accessory. You can see all these online. A lot of people stopped me when they saw my case. They said, "Ohhhh, Hey, what case is that?" "Is that a cell phone case?" I think it is the case the iPhone deserves. Before this I had this Belkin case which was plastic and transparent and you can see the phone. But this definitely gives a more professional look. And with the clip, I just feel a lot more comfortable having the phone on my side and being able to clip it, makes me feel like I am not going to loose it. And the clip rotates, it rotates and spins to adjust exactly to what you are trying to do. And the clip moves with you. And in some cases the clip is attached to the back and it rips off, this clip is not like that, it is solid, and it will not rip off. Because, you can detach the clip, you just use it regular like that. You just pop it off and on the clip.

---Charles: When using the case did you have any problem using the iPhone? Does it interfere at all with the functionality of the phone?

--- Doug: No, it does not. They have all the proper holes cut out. So I can access all my external buttons that I needed to get to. And the lid gives a nice protection for the screen. This is the best case that I have ever come across in terms of the iPhone. I know there are a lot of iPhone cases out there. But if you want a case that is very stylish, and is functional, I am with you and I will give it an "A".
